## Hanging flower basket in a shape of falcon bait container with crane motifs

### Materials

Bamboo and metal

### Description

Cone shaped hanaire, or wall hanging basket - possibly a falconers bait basket - of natural/blond bamboo. The bamboo strips are approximately two inches wide and are woven in a loose twill plait. The widest part of the basket is at a high shoulder which then briefly narrows to the

neck/rim. Rim and shoulder are wrapped in rattan. Tiny metallic gold, black, and red cranes are painted in lacquer above and below the shoulder, with three more midway down the body. The basket is meant to be hung on a wall. There is a short length of brown ribbon tied through a slat at the shoulder for this purpose.
