A twill woven rattan and bamboo basket with lid (B-1054a-b) and ten furoshiki (B-1054c-l). The furoshiki are silk and are varied in color and pattern. B-1054c is white with purple irises. B-1054d is green with a floral pattern pinched in the fabric. B-1054e is purple with large white flowers with gold highlights. B-1054f is purple with thin white flowers. B-1054g is yellow with a blue crescent and two parrots. B-1054h is red, off-white, and green with six small figures pulling a wagon with an overflowing large bouquet of flowers. B-1054i is mustard with an abstract off-white floral pattern. B-1054j is off-white with five birds with black-tipped wings and red heads. B-1054k is purple shibori. B-1054l is off-white with a scene of a boat underneath a weeping-branched tree rendered in mustard, blue, green, brown and red.
